Important e-Safety Alert

As you may be aware from local media this week, on Tuesday a serious e-Safety incident was reported at Westgate Primary School in Otley. Children in Y6 using the app **Live.ly** were involved in a group chat on Monday evening which was joined by a man not known to them. The children in guestion were exposed to inappropriate content.

Whilst the app is only supposed to access contacts on the user's phone, it appears that quite quickly, friends of friends are able to join the group chat whom your child does not know at all. It is therefore an unsafe app for children to use, as it risks either an incident such as happened on Monday, or opportunities for your child to be groomed online and therefore at risk of exploitation.

I would therefore urge that your child does not have access to this app on their phone.

The children's parents informed their school which has reported the matter to the police and Leeds City Council's Safeguarding team. The Leeds safeguarding team have reported that this is at least the second call they have had about similar concerns with this app in a week.

Live.ly is connected to music.ly, the safety of which is also in question. If your child experiences anything like this online, it must be reported to the police using 101. Please talk to your child about the importance of telling you immediately if anything happens to them online that makes them uncomfortable or scared.

I have spoken to both Y5 and Y6 about the dangers of this app, asked them to delete it from their phones if they use it, and reiterated key e-safety messages.
