Summer Uniform reminder

During the summer months please make sure you child has a **sun hat in school** (labelled please!) Please put sun cream on pupils before they come to school. Eight hour creams are available which will keep them protected all day, suncream cannot be applied by staff in school. On very sunny days, pupils without a sun hat will be asked to sit in the shelter to avoid the risk of sunburn.

Girls may wish to wear a school dress in summer - this must be **red and white** check or stripe. Boys may wear **smart navy** school shorts, casual board shorts are not allowed.

Please also ensure you child has a waterproof jacket with them each day as our weather is very changeable!

Sports for Champions visit

As a school, we have been offered an exciting opportunity to welcome a Team GB athlete to Tranmere Park. Our athlete will be coming on Monday 16th July and will be doing some circuit work with each class in school. After this, they will hold a whole-school assembly, explaining how they became an athlete and the qualities a sports person needs.

The athlete that will be coming to our school is Beth Dobbin. She is a Scottish member of Team GB and participates in athletics events such as the 100m, 200m and 4 x 100m relay. She recently broke the Scottish 200m record, running it in 22.84 seconds, breaking a record that had previously been held for 34 years.

A letter was sent out this week regarding this exciting opportunity. On the front, it explained what was happening and how it works. On the back of this sheet, there was a sponsorship form. Important Safeguarding Alert

We have been made aware of a person using Instagram to target young boys to send nude photos of themselves to him using various coercions, threats and menaces. The person seems most interested in primary school aged boys. If your child has an Instagram account, I would advise that you check their account. The accounts causing concerned are _ally_law__123 or _ally_law__. The person claims to be a prolific Youtuber who does various risky pranks such as walking on the glass roofs of large shopping centres in broad daylight. The account may be somebody not connected in any way to this Youtuber.

If your child is following the account and there have been no concerning approaches, we would advise you to block the person's account. If there has been concerning or suspicious activity, please contact the police by ringing 101. It may be advisable to take screenshots before blocking the account so you have examples of any concerning messages.

We thought it might be useful to share this top tip for helping to manage your child's online activities. Please note this only works for PC's & Xbox, not Apple products or playstations and doesn't work on most mobile phones. This is quite a basic level of parental control, there are some more advanced app based systems which you can use on mobiles etc but they are quite expensive.

This Microsoft version gives a good degree of control of both the hours that your child has access, the amount of screen time and limits to age restricted content they can see whilst on there. For example, they could have access from 4-7pm on a weekday but only 1 hour per day of screen time. You can also set separate limits for the Xbox & PC. It also means that every member of the family can have different time limits & levels of access.

It's fairly simple to set up & manage & the above link will get you started. There are 3 main steps.

- 1. Set each member of the family up with a Microsoft account (they'll need an email address)
- 2. The administrator then invites the others to join the family
- 3. The administrator can set the parameters time frame, hours of screen time & age content restrictions.

If you need to allow them extra time, they can either send you a request which you can accept (or not) or you can log on & change the restrictions.
