Activity	Details
<p>EYFS (What makes our world special?)</p>	<p>Draw/Paint/Create a picture of something in our natural world that you think is really special. Label your picture then write a sentence that tells us why you think it is special.</p> <p>Challenge: Complete the task as a collage of things you think are special.</p>
<p>KS1 (What do you love about our world?)</p>	<p>Create a poem that shares all the things you love about our world. From sunsets to cats, or ice-cream to friends, your poem can contain anything that you love!</p> <p>Extension: Illustrate your poem.</p>
<p>LKS2 (How can we care for our world?)</p>	<p>Choose something from our world that needs care and attention, for example, the forests, the oceans, the air we breathe, or the people and animals we share our planet with and create a set of instructions, in poem form, showing someone how to look after it.</p> <p>Extension: Illustrate your poem.</p>
<p>UKS2 (Can you give our world a voice?)</p>	<p>Choose something in our world that doesn't have a human voice and lend it one, sharing in poem form how it would ask us to look after / sustain it for years to come.</p> <p>Extension: Illustrate your poem.</p>
